Both began as young associates, Goldstein in 1995 and LePore in 2001, growing with the practice and ultimately stepping into leadership as a new generation shaped its future. In July 2025, the firm formally transitioned into Goldstein LePore, marking both continuity and evolution.

Today, Goldstein LePore represents owners, managers, and developers of multifamily residential and commercial properties throughout New Jersey. The firm focuses on complex landlord-tenant matters,

housing discrimination cases, and commercial litigation, areas requiring both legal precision and practical business insight. By maintaining a focused niche rather than a broad general practice, the attorneys anticipate challenges others may overlook and guide clients through evolving legal landscapes with clarity and confidence. Goldstein's interest in law began early, shaped by her mother's emphasis on independence and reinforced through participation in a Youth Court program where she served as a defense attorney, an experience that solidified her commitment to advocacy. LePore was similarly influenced by growing up around the legal profession through her father and grandfather, as well as by her grandmother, a pioneering female business leader whose resilience helped shape her perspective on leadership.

What distinguishes the firm most is the depth of its relationships. That continuity is supported by a strong, experienced team whose knowledge and attention to detail help manage complex matters efficiently while maintaining a personalized approach. For Goldstein and

Operating within a traditionally male-dominated litigation environment has shaped their leadership perspective as well. Both attorneys emphasize that credibility comes from preparation, knowledge, and presence, a philosophy reflected in their active roles shaping the profession. Goldstein serves on key judicial and bar association committees influencing landlord-tenant procedure, and the firm has handled appellate matters that have helped shape legal precedent across New Jersey. Their influence also extends through involvement with organizations including the New Jersey State Bar Association and the New Jersey Apartment Association, where they help shape conversations around legal procedure and industry standards.
